Title: Middle School Girls Soccer Coach

Reports To: Athletic Director

Job Purpose: Guiding, teaching, and mentoring young female student-athletes. This position focuses on skill development, game strategy, and most importantly, fostering a positive, Christ-centered team environment. The goal is to develop both the athlete's Christian character and their soccer abilities, emphasizing teamwork, sportsmanship, and personal growth in a competitive, yet nurturing, atmosphere.

POSITION QUALIFICATIONS

- Strong evidence of a personal relationship with Jesus Christ that is demonstrated in word and deed.
- **Experience:** Previous playing experience, with coaching experience at the club, middle school, or high school level preferred, but not required.
- **Certifications:** CPR/AED and First Aid certification (or willingness to obtain). Also complete required online training modules.
- **Skills:** Strong communication skills, ability to manage middle-school aged students, and a servant-leader spirit.

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

Spiritual Leadership & Mentorship:

- 1) Integrate biblical principles into coaching, using soccer to teach Christian values.
- 2) Serve as a positive Christian role model in attitude, speech, and actions, both on and off the field.
- 3) Lead or facilitate devotionals and prayer at practices and before games.
- 4) Encourage athletes to discover and maximize their God-given talents.

Coaching & Development:

- 5) Plan and execute age-appropriate, daily practice sessions focusing on fundamental skills (passing, shooting, dribbling) and teamwork.
- 6) Develop and implement effective game strategies.
- 7) Emphasize sportsmanship and grace in both winning and losing.
- 8) Foster a safe, encouraging environment for personal and athletic growth.
- 9) Partner with the Varsity coach to help build a total soccer program.

Administrative & Safety Duties:

- 10) Supervise student-athletes during all practices and games, including travel.
- 11) Maintain open communication with parents via FACTS (Renweb), utilizing the software's email and texting features.

School Community Engagement:

- 12) Actively contribute to the school culture, upholding its mission and values.
- 13) Attend required athletic department meetings and end-of-season banquets.
- 14) Partner with the athletic director on scheduling, transportation, and logistics.
